NOTES FOR POSTGRADUATE APPLICANTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2010/11

Please read these notes carefully before completing the application form.

- 1) The Intercollegiate Halls will only accept applications from registered full-time students of the University of London. Part time students may only apply in exceptional circumstances.
- 2) Acceptance is for one academic year only. Applications for a second year will be considered during January of 2011 and acceptance is strictly limited.
- 3) All Intercollegiate Halls are strictly non-smoking.
- 4) All halls accommodate both male and female students. Some halls have segregated floors and you should state when applying if you require this option.
- 5) The catering provision varies between the halls. Please see individual Hall information for further details. Students with specific dietary requirements should consult the Bursar's Office of the hall before applying.
- 6) All residents must pay a fixed subscription to the halls elected Student Social Committee, who control their own expenditure and whose sole function is to further the interests of the student body.
- 7) All successful applicants must pay a deposit and registration fee on acceptance of an offer. The deposit is held by the University against future charges and may not be used against any part of the fees. The residue is ultimately returnable under specified conditions. The registration fee is not refundable. Please read the terms and conditions on the acceptance form carefully.
- 8) No student may spend more than two years in hall accommodation except in very special circumstances.

Applications for September 2010/11

All accommodation must be applied for via your college accommodation office.

Please contact your college accommodation office for application procedures. Information concerning selection criteria is available from your college.

LSHTM students should complete the University of London application form and return it to the Intercollegiate Halls Accommodation Bureau before June 30th 2010. Details of the LSHTM selection criteria are available on the LSHTM website.

London Business School students should contact uolhallsinfo@london.edu for application information.

Imperial college students will only be eligible for accommodation if they have elected to pursue a University of London degree.

Family Accommodation at International Hall:

Please apply directly to the Intercollegiate Halls Accommodation Bureau using the University of London application form. The deadline for applying is June 30th 2010 after which a waiting list will be held.

Students who are not in their first year of study during the 2010/11 academic year should contact their college accommodation offices for advice as they cannot apply directly to the Intercollegiate Halls until the waiting list on the 9th September 2010.

Waiting List

A waiting list for late or unsuccessful applicants will be held on 9th September 2010 for all halls. Further details will be posted on the University of London website in early September 2010.

Applications after September 9th 2010

All applications for halls should be sent directly to the Intercollegiate Halls Accommodation Bureau where mid-term waiting lists are held. Applications are accepted by email, fax or in person.
